Angelique

One of the most popular tulips, Angelique is a flawless, pale rose beauty with darker rose flushes and pale creamy-pink edges. Fragrant. Blooms late April. Approx 18".



Avignon

Award-winning, brilliant warm-red with fire-red edges tulip with a small yellow base visible from inside the bloom. Ideal to mix with oranges, peaches and yellows. Late bloomer 26"



Daydream

Changing in color throughout the duration of its bloom, this magical tulip has varying shades of soft apricot, warm orange and yellow with a rosy glow. Fragrant. Blooms mid April to May. 22".



Flaming Parrot

Flaming Parrot is an excellent combination of flamed brilliant red and buttercup-yellow. Guaranteed to wake up a sleepy spring garden with a jolt of color. Known as the most widely used tulip for cut-flower arrangements. Late bloomer, strong stems, 22"



King Alfred Narcissus

This is a beautiful, most beloved daffodil of all that will bring continuing pleasure to the garden for years to come. Single, yellow – the classic! Grows 18-20"



Rijnvelds Early Sensation Narcissus

Circa 1943, this dazzling golden trumpet-type daffodil blooms early, tolerates cold, snowy weather with a long blooming period. Another classic year after year! 18"



Thalia Narcissus

This wonderfully fragrant "orchid narcissus" has two to five snow white flowers per stem, returning year after year with proper care. It is the oldest known hybrid (1610), originating from SW Europe. Grows 16"



Ziva Paperwhites

A long time favorite for inside forcing, Ziva yields large trusses of fragrant, snow-white flowers. Up to three stems per bulb. Flowers in four to six weeks. Best potted from mid-October to the end of February.

All bulbs will be available after October 1, 2009.
