Can you **find examples** in the museum of every color on the wheel? Make marks inside the colors on the wheel each time you see them.



AT MINT MUSEUM RANDOLPH

What colors do Queen Charlotte and King George III wear in their coronation portraits? **If you were royalty**, what colors would you wear for dressy occasions?



AT HOME

Select 2 complementary colors (any two colors directly opposite each other on the color wheel, like red and green). Draw a self-portrait using **only these 2 colors**.
