Abstract	The Crutchfield Collection contains numerous artifacts and data relating to 'The Queen's Mintkins' performing arts program. The series for the collection are: images (which includes images of the puppets, marionettes, portable stages, and behind the scenes), scripts (ranging from Halloween to Christmas- dates unknown, and promotional scripts for the Museum's upcoming events), correspondence (letters to and from Mrs. Crutchfield, and letters between her associates), master catalogue (detailing how to animate the puppets and marionettes, also includes scripts, and Book List, Records List, Music and Sound Effects guides, and Manipulation Exercises), Mint Auxillary (primarily detailing the Antiques show, sponsored by the Mint Auxillary), and Miscellaneous (which includes the paperwork and billing associated with giving the puppets and marionettes as a gift to the Mint Museum; a pamphlet detailing the memorial of Mrs. Crutchfield, and The 29th Annual Puppetry Festival: The puppeteers of America booklet (June 29-July 5, 1964)).

### **Biographical/Historical note**

Jacqueline Crutchfield was an important member of the Mint Museum's Performing Arts Department. Her primary involvement was in establishing and coordinating 'The Queen's Mintkins'; a collection of hand and stick puppets and marionettes. The Crutchfield Collection hosts numerous artifacts including scripts, costumes, letters between Mrs. Crutchfield and her associates, and manuals for puppeteering. This collection demonstrates a significant time in the Mint Museum's History when children's outreach programs were of particular interest, and further conveys data about life at the Mint Museum and its Performing Arts Program from 1960-1993.
