Philip Anthony Moose was a native of Newton, NC. He lived from 1921 until 2001. He taught art at Davidson College and a Queens College in North Carolina. Among his awards are the 1947 Pulitzer Award for Art, Fulbright scholarships, and a Tiffany award. Moose not only painted landscapes and portraits in his native region and country but also painted abstracts as well as scenes from his lifelong world travels. He was a realistic and abstract painter using water color and oil paints.
